## What's the difference between the IRR and the IWA?

The most important difference between the **IRR** (Individual Research Report) and the **IWA** (Individual Written Argument) is that the IRR is a **report**, and the IWA is an **argument**.

The **IRR** simply reported the information that you found in researching your team's topic through your lens; this research later became part of <u>the team's argument</u>, which is presented in the Team Multimedia Presentation (TMP). Together, these two--IRR and TMP--comprise <u>Task Performance 1</u>.

The **IWA**, by contrast, is <u>itself an argument</u>, built on the research that you conduct in an effort to respond to your own research question(s). Once you've written your IWA, you will create your Individual Multimedia Presentation (IMP). Together, these two--IWA and IMP--comprise <u>Task</u> <u>Performance 2</u>.
