HIGHLIGHTING: marking the text

- 1. underline important ideas
- 2. **box** key terms
- 3. number a series of related points
- 4. **circle** an unfamiliar word (or place a question mark beside it)
- 5. **draw vertical lines** in the margin beside a particularly interesting passage
- 6. draw arrows to connect related points
- 7. star discussions of the work's central issues or themes

ANNOTATING: having a conversation with the text through marginal notes

- 1. **ask** questions
- 2. make an observation, prediction, or inference
- 3. **suggest** possible connections/parallels with other reading selections or with your own experiences
- 4. argue with the writer's points
- 5. comment on the writer's style
- 6. define unfamiliar terms and concepts
- 7. summarize important ideas
